

Fund Allocation Guidelines

The following are the guidelines of the Canadian Tire JumpStart Program for your local chapter.

1. Grants will not exceed a maximum of \$300 per application
2. For children and youth between the ages of 4 and 18 years of age.
3. Funds are awarded for registration fees, equipment and/or transportation costs.
4. Funding is available for members of the same family for the same season.
5. Funding must be for ongoing physical activities/programs that last a season.
6. Funding is allocated twice a year- spring/summer (deadline date is May 1st) and fall/winter (deadline date is October 1st).
7. Incomplete applications forms will be sent back to the applicant for completion if required.
8. Cheques for registration grants will be made payable to a league, association or club.
9. We cover the counties of Kent, Albert and Westmorland.
